## **ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT**

(Transcription)

Articles of agreement made the Seventh Day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand and Eight Hundred & Eleven – between Jacob J. Hasbrouck & Isaiah Hasbrouck of the Town of New paltz County of Ulster & State of New =york of the first part & Josiah Eltinge William Hasbrouck Philip Dayo, Andries Lefever Jun of the Second part. Witnesseth that ^if the Said parties of the first part Do apprehend Tom a negro man belonging to the Said Josiah Eltinge, Harry a negro man Belonging to the Said W<sup>m</sup> Hasbrouck, Sime a negro man the property of Philip Dayo Ceasar a negro man the property of the Said Andries Lefever Jun they may Sell and Dispose of the Said negroes and retain the one moiety thereof for their troubles & Expences [sic] for apprehending the Said negroes and return the other moiety to the reflective owners of Said Slaves, And should the Said parties of the first part not apprehend any of Said negroes they promise and agree to and with the Said parties of the Second part to make no Charge for their trouble time nor Expence they may Sustain in the procuring or apprehending of Said negroes.
